

First Paragraph:

(Introduce the topic and your general ideas here)

1. State the topic sentence here and use as many of the original words from the topic as you can so the reader knows exactly what this essay is about.
2. State your first general idea sentence here that you're going to use to explain this topic and make sure you keep it a general statement.
3. State your second different general idea sentence here that you're going to use to explain this topic and make sure you keep it a general statement.
4. State your conclusion sentence here by mentioning both general ideas together in this sentence but try and use different words to say it.

Second Paragraph:

(Explain only your first general idea in this paragraph by giving examples)

1. State the first general idea sentence here again from paragraph one but use different words to say it so the reader knows exactly what this paragraph is about.
2. Then give your first specific example here to explain this general idea.
3. Next, give your second different specific example here again to explain this general idea.
4. In your conclusion sentence for this paragraph try to briefly mention your specific examples here to wrap up this paragraph.

Third paragraph:

(Explain only your second general idea in this paragraph by giving examples)

1. State the second general idea sentence here again from paragraph one but use different words to say it so the reader knows exactly what this paragraph is about.
2. Then give your first specific example here to explain this general idea.
3. Next, give your second different specific example here to explain this general idea.
4. In your conclusion sentence for this paragraph try and briefly mention your specific examples here to wrap up this paragraph.

Fourth Paragraph:

(This is the conclusion paragraph for this essay where you recap everything)

1. State the first sentence here from paragraph one only use different words to say it in order to reiterate the topic.
2. State the first general idea here from paragraph one but use different words to say it.
3. State the second different general idea here from paragraph one but use different words to say it.
4. State your, "I think" sentence here about this topic. Give your personal opinion here about this topic, either you like it or you don't.
